Dear Representative Calvert:

The Fleet Reserve Association (FRA) supports your legislation (H.R. 4941) that will ensure military reservists will receive Post 9/11 GI Bill benefits as intended by correcting an unintended issue that causes reservists who report for active duty under Title 10 to lose their entire Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) and book stipend. Just one day of Title 10 service can result in forfeiture of MHA and book stipend for all or most of the month. The bill will ensure the MHA is prorated for the portion of the month the service member is not on active duty.

The Association appreciates your leadership on this issue and stands ready to provide assistance in advancing this legislation.
