## Dear Chairmen Takano and Tester:

The Fleet Reserve Association (FRA) wants to express its concern about the reduce number of organizations allowed to testify at hearings before the annual joint House and Senate Veterans Affairs Committees. For many years FRA has been allowed to testify. The Association is Congressionally Chartered in 1996, recognized by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), and entrusted to serve all veterans who seek its help. FRA would like to suggest that veteran's organizations that are Congressionally Chartered should be given a preference when selecting organizations to testify.

FRA notes that many veterans' groups, like FRA, that represents enlisted members exclusively (AFSA, NCOA, NERA, EANGUS, and TREA) were denied an opportunity to testify. Yet enlisted personnel make up more than 80 percent of the military.

FRA is a leader in the military/veteran's organization community and represents current and former Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard enlisted personnel on compensation, benefits and quality of life programs and works to improve benefits for these service members, their families, and survivors.
